**AUDIT CLAIMS AGAINST THE COUNTY AND AUTHORIZE THEIR PAYMENT - TREASURER** - Commissioner Jumper made a motion to approve payment of the claims against the county and Commissioner Emerson seconded the motion. Motion carried. **See Exhibit 9-20-2017 - A**
