CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING DEFINITIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN FRANKLIN COUNTY AND TITUS REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER (TRMC) FOR EMERGENCY

MEDICAL TRANSPORT SERVICES – COUNTY JUDGE – Judge Lovier reported Brent Smith from Hopkins County Emergency Medical Services would like to address the court. Mr. Smith gave an overview of what Hopkins County EMS could do for Franklin County. John Allen, CEO from Titus County Regional Medical Center also addressed the Court. A few questions were asked by Commissioner Elect Larkin Jumper, Auditor Tina Phillips, and Treasurer Betty Sue Allen. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the Definitive Agreement between Franklin County and Titus County Regional Medical Center (TRMC) for Emergency Medical Transport Services and Commissioner Surratt seconded the motion.
