## CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING FRANKLIN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL FOUNDATION'S REQUEST FOR FRANKLIN COUNTY TO JOIN TEX-21 - BOB MCFARLAND

Bob McFarland, Executive Director of the Franklin County Industrial Foundation encouraged the County to join TEX-21 and support the effort to upgrade Interstate 30. He reported the opening of the expanded Panama Canal is projected to occur in the first half of 2016 and will double the capacity of the Canal and increase the truck traffic on Interstate 30. TEX-21 is bringing the I-30 communities together to educate the Legislature on the improvements needed to accommodate the increase in traffic. All the counties from Dallas to Texarkana are members of TEX-21 with the exception of Franklin and Morris Counties. Mr. McFarland recommended Franklin County to make the commitment now and pay dues in the amount of \$2,125.00 in January 2015. Commissioner Surratt made a motion to approve Franklin County joining TEX-21 and Commissioner Chitsey seconded the motion. Commissioner Young abstained and the motion carried with three commissioners and the County Judge voting in favor.

CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING PROPOSAL FROM MMI FOR INSTALLATION OF SECURITY WALL IN THE COURTHOUSE FOR THE JUSTICE OF THE PEACE OFFICE — COUNTY JUDGE — Commissioner Surratt made a motion to approve MMI's proposal in the amount of \$5,300 for the installation of a security wall in the courthouse for the Justice of the Peace office and Commissioner Carr seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Auditor Tina Phillips reported these funds could be paid out of the Courthouse funds 034. See Volume 1X Page \_\_\_\_\_

CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING PROPOSAL FROM MMI TO REMOVE AND REPLACE CONCRETE WALKS ON EITHER SIDE OF THE WEST ENTRANCE FROM THE STAIRS AT THE CITY SIDEWALK TO THE STAIRS AT THE WEST BASEMENT ENTRANCE AND TO REMOVE AND REPLACE THE TWO RETAINING WALLS, ONE NORTH AND ONE SOUTH RUNNING ALONG THE WALKWAY BE REPLACED – COUNTY JUDGE — Commissioner Carr made a motion to approve the MMI's proposal in the amount of \$4,976.00 to remove and replace the concrete walks on either side of the west entrance from the stairs at the city sidewalk to the stairs at the west basement entrance and to remove and replace the two retaining walls, one North and one South running along the walkway be replaced. <u>COURTHOUSE RESTORATION</u> — Bill Wilson reported the fence on top of the retaining wall in the parking lot north of the courthouse had been installed, the final painting has started, the sound and the AV system has been installed and he reported they will be getting three small benches from the District Courtroom at the Annex to begin restoration.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS:** Commissioner Precinct 2, Donnie Surratt announced he will retire on December 31, 2014 and will be filling a Certificate of Withdrawal to remove his name from the ballot with the County Clerk's office today. He went on to say he was not sick. He just wanted to be able to spend time with his family and grandchildren.

Commissioner Surratt made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Commissioner Young seconded the motion. Motion carried.
