Commissioner Young called the meeting to order.

Commissioner Young introduced Wayne Defenbaugh, from Blackland Railroad and Phil Davilla, the executive director of NETEX. NETEX owns the line and Blackland Railroad owns the train. Mr. Defenbaugh presented a power point showing the economic value that the railroad has. At this time the railroad runs from Winfield to Greenville. He presented the economic outcome and showed the benefits of the railroad was to Franklin County. It could increase businesses and create jobs. Increase the car load growth, rail car traffic and increase the revenue. He reported they are wanting to upgrade the track to make it more efficient and to increase the speed. He reported they are in talks with Lowes with the possibility of Lowes using the rail car to bring freight into Franklin County. Trans loading provides unloading and loading possibilities for local hauling and we are trying to increase rail car activity and revenue.
