<u>SECOND READING: REPLAT LOT 1R PHASE IV EAGLE POINT AND 2.633 ACRES – RALPH</u> <u>ROBERTSON FOR LARRY AND ANN ADAMS -</u> Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the second reading of replat of lot 1R of Phase IV, Eagle Point and 2.633 acres and Commissioner Jumper seconded the motion. He reported a phone had been added to the elevator and it is ADA complaint. After discussion, Commissioner Carr made a motion to table this agenda item. The funding of a maintenance agreement for the elevator at the Franklin County Historical Association building at the Old Fire Station Museum will be considered in 2017 budget hearings. Treasurer Betty Sue Allen stated she will research and see how much it will cost to add to this to the policy. Commissioner Jumper seconded the motion and the motion carried to table the agenda item.

<u>CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON REVIEWING BIDS AND APPROVING PURCHASE OF 8</u> <u>SETS OF BLEACHERS FOR FRANKLIN COUNTY SPORTS COMPLEX – BILL TRAVIS -</u> After discussion, Commissioner Chitsey made a motion to approve purchasing eight sets of bleachers from SturdiSteel in the amount of \$11,360.00 for the Franklin County Sports Complex and Commissioner Carr seconded the motion. CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING ADVERTISING FOR BIDS FOR ROAD MATERIALS, CULVERTS AND FUEL – TREASURER - Commissioner Carr made a motion to approve advertising for bids for road materials, culverts and fuel. The bids are to be opened on May 23, 2016 with the new fees becoming effective June 1st and Commissioner Chitsey seconded the motion. Motion carried.

<u>CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING QUOTE FROM TOM SCOTT LUMBER YARD</u> <u>FOR GENERATOR ENCLOSURE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,492.82 – TODD CONRADSON –</u> Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the quote from Tom Scott Lumber Yard in the amount of \$3,492.82 for material to enclose the generator at the courthouse and Commissioner Chitsey seconded the motion. <u>CONSIDER AND TAKE ACTION ON APPROVING WHETHER TO EXTEND CURRENT</u> <u>AMBULANCE SERVICE CONTRACT WITH TITUS REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER FOR ONE</u> <u>YEAR, EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2017 OR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A NEW TWO-YEAR</u> <u>CONTRACT BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2018 – COUNTY</u> <u>JUDGE – After discussion, Commissioner Young made a motion to go out for bids for ambulance</u> service for a new two year contract beginning January 1, 2017 and ending December 31, 2018. Commissioner Jumper seconded the motion and the motion carried.

 Maintenance Manager Todd Conradson reported on December 16, 2015 the 1911 bell strike hammer broke in half. After doing lots of research he reported taking the broken bell strike hammer to Larry Baily of Henderson Manufacturing Company, Inc. in Pittsburg on February 4, 2016. Mr. Bailey took the broken bell strike hammer to Ted Edward Keen and Patricia Crowe Keen at Superior Cast Metals in Houston. Todd reported receiving a new replica of the hammer on April 13, 2016. Todd requested the county to show appreciation for the restorative work done on the hammer. The County will present a plaque to them in appreciation of the work done on the bell strike hammer.

- Commissioner Chitsey reported doing work on a section of a road (Carr Street) that ties into a county road. He reported the City is responsible for the work on that stretch of the road.
- Family and Consumer Sciences Extension Agent Lindsey Yeager reported on recent events and activities she had attended as well as informed the court about future events and activities coming up.
- Judge Lee reminded everyone about the employee appreciation luncheon to be held on Wednesday.
- Auditor Tina Phillips discussed some legislative issues and scheduled a workshop on May 9th from 10:00 – 12:00 to discuss the 2017 budget. She also suggested inviting State Representative Gary VanDeaver to our budget workshop. She also encouraged everyone to contact legislative representatives and let them know you feel about legislative issues.
